

Teaching Internship

Sweetland School seeks candidates for a teaching internship to support a vibrant elementary school engaging in the arts and project based learning.

Interns will assist in classrooms and support small group work, working and learning with teachers. Documentation will be a key area of support, photographing, collecting ideas of children and preserving this information will be a part of the daily practices. Interns will also support building student portfolios throughout the year.

The Internship program serves those interested in understanding arts integrated and project based learning in a K-6 environment. Interested applicants are asked to submit cover letter, resume and application attached and available online at www.sweettreearts.org. - Sweetland School.

Interns will spend three days, from September to June, at the school and immerse themselves in Sweetland School's schedule, organization, curricula, methods, and theories of teaching.

This is a paid internship opportunity \$3500, 10 hours a week at \$10 an hour for 35 weeks. Shorter 6 - 10 week terms are available

Sweetland teachers review applications and select interns in July. Our criteria include adherence to the guidelines established in this letter; completeness of the application; and compatibility of a teacher's vision and sense of purpose with those of Sweetland School.

Applicants are notified of our decision by August 1.
